Brief outline of tour

The tours vary year to year, are up market and of high value and focus on interesting experiences, top food experiences, very comfortable accommodation and small numbers, e.g. in 2017 tours include: Persian Delights, Croatian Beauty; To Russia with Love – Moscow, Kazan and St Petersburg; Autumn in Japan; Jambo Jambo Kenya Couture. Within Australia trips include short trips to Adelaide and the Barossa and one to Hepburn Springs/Daylesford. There is the option of a single or share room.

In planning for 2018 are:

- April: Essence of Vietnam plus Halong Bay extension
- July: Galapagos, Quito & Peru
- August: Hepburn & Daylesford
- September: Tastes of Rome and Sicily; Spanish Food Safari (Andalucia)

There is also the Gorillas in Africa (plus a little more) and a private jet extravaganza in Oz to look out for.
